The City of Hallsville, Missouri, was established as a fourth-class city in 1957 and operates under a Mayor–Aldermen–City Administrator form of government. The Mayor is elected at-large for a two-year term and serves as the official head of the city, casting a vote only in the event of a tie.

The Board of Aldermen consists of members elected from their respective wards, with two representatives from each ward. Ward 1 includes the area north of Route 00, extending west along Route 124, north on Bertie, and west to Route U. Ward 2 includes all areas south of Route 00. Board members serve two-year terms and are responsible for establishing policies that guide the city's operations.

The City of Hallsville provides water services and street maintenance through its Public Works Department. Trash collection services are contracted through Dayne's Waste Disposal. Bulky trash pick-up is scheduled for the third Wednesday of each month.

The administrative structure of the City includes the Office of the Mayor, the Office of the City Administrator, the Public Works Department, and the Hallsville Police Department. Additional details regarding services provided by these departments are outlined in later sections of this handbook.

Through its Board of Aldermen and administrative leadership, the City of Hallsville remains committed to serving its residents. Our elected officials strive to uphold a government that is truly by the people and for the people.

## City Offices and Departments

### **Office of the Mayor (Telephone: 573-696-3885)**

The Mayor serves as the Chief Executive Officer of the City of Hallsville. Responsibilities include presiding over the Board of Aldermen meetings and casting a vote in the event of a tie. The Mayor also represents the City at meetings, events, and community gatherings on behalf of residents and elected officials.

### **Office of the City Administrator (Telephone: 573-696-3885)**

The Office of the City Administrator includes the City Administrator/City Clerk and a Deputy Clerk. This office provides building applications, accepts utility payments, issues pet licenses, and offers notary, faxing, and copying services to the community. It is responsible for managing city funds and supporting decision-making across departments. The office also receives and directs messages to appropriate department heads.

### **Public Works Department (Telephone: 573-696-3885)**

The Public Works Department is responsible for the maintenance, repair, and testing of city water lines. The department also maintains city-owned buildings, streets, and parks. Additional responsibilities include construction site setback checks, inspections, and general upkeep of city infrastructure.

### **Hallsville Police Department (Non-Emergency: 311 | Emergency: 911)**

The Hallsville Police Department includes a Police Chief, Police Sergeant, full-time and part-time officers, and a School Resource Officer. The department is responsible for maintaining public safety, investigating criminal activity, and enforcing federal, state, and municipal laws. Officers maintain a visible presence and are committed to protecting and serving the community.

# Summary of Municipal Ordinances

## Pet Ordinances:

The City of Hallsville requires a license for all dogs and cats over six months of age. Pet owners must provide proof of a current rabies vaccination and pay an annual fee of \$3.00 for spayed or neutered pets and \$5.00 for non-spayed or non-neutered pets. Licenses must be displayed on the pet's collar to assist in identifying ownership if the animal is picked up.

Pet tags are renewed annually in August. A late fee of \$25.00 applies if a license is more than 60 days past expiration. Dogs running at large are prohibited. If a dog is picked up, a boarding fee of \$50.00 per day will be charged in addition to any citation issued.

Excessive barking or nuisance behavior is not permitted. Pet owners must provide proper food, water, shelter, and care. Households are limited to a maximum of four pets (cats and/or dogs).

## Public Nuisances:

The City of Hallsville enforces a public nuisance ordinance to protect property owners and maintain community standards. A full copy of this ordinance is available at City Hall.

Examples of violations include: unlicensed vehicles, accumulation of trash or debris, outdoor storage of appliances, odor-producing substances, outdoor bathroom facilities, standing water, and grass or weeds exceeding seven inches in height.

## Other Ordinance Information:

The City regulates speed limits on all streets, which are posted accordingly. Excessive or unnecessary noise is prohibited. Additional ordinances address criminal violations such as stealing, property damage, trespassing, assault, possession of marijuana, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

## Board of Aldermen Meetings

Meetings are held on the second Monday of each month at 7:00 PM in the Hallsville City Hall Conference Room.

## Municipal Court

Court date: Second Tuesday after the first Monday of each month at 9:00 AM.

Payments cannot be made earlier than 15 days from ticket issue date.

## Trash Collection & Disposal Guidelines

Dayne's Waste Disposal Inc. is the approved residential waste collection provider for the City of Hallsville. Regular trash pickup occurs every Wednesday. Residents are asked to place trash at the curb the evening prior to collection.

Monthly service rate: \$17.25

### Collection Guidelines:

- Trash containers over 44 gallons: No loose trash; all items must be bagged.
- Bags must be 13 gallons or larger and weigh less than 50 lbs.
- Containers under 44 gallons must not exceed 50 lbs total weight.

### Unacceptable Waste:

- Hazardous materials (including asbestos, chemicals, pesticides, flammable liquids)
- Tires, explosives, medical waste, infectious waste
- Lead-acid batteries, waste oils, raw sewage
- Construction debris, dead animals, yard waste
- Paints (unless latex-based and fully dried in an open container)

### Bulky Item Pickup:

Bulky trash pickup is scheduled for the third Wednesday of each month.

Accepted items include furniture, beds, and other large household items.

### Items Not Accepted for Bulky Pickup:

Appliances such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, stoves, washing machines, and water heaters are not included.

Residents may contact City Hall to schedule special pickup for these items.

## Water & Trash Billing Information

Billing for City of Hallsville water and trash services is due by the 10th of each month. A 5% late fee will be applied to any balance remaining after the 10th. Accounts not paid by the 20th of the month will incur

a \$35.00 non-payment fee and will be subject to service disconnection.

To restore service, all outstanding balances, including late fees and non-payment fees, must be paid in full. A \$25.00 reconnection fee will be charged for services restored during regular business hours (Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM).

**Tribble Park**

Tribble Park is located on Route 00 and is owned and maintained by the City of Hallsville. The park is open seasonally from March through October and operates daily from sunrise to sunset.

Shelter houses are available for rent through City Hall for a fee of \$20.00.

The use of alcohol and illegal drugs is strictly prohibited within the park.

## Hallsville Community Center

The Hallsville Community Center is available for rent through City Hall. The rental fee is \$125.00 per day, or \$50.00 per day for non-profit organizations. A \$100.00 security deposit is required at the time of booking.

### **Alcohol Policy:**

The consumption of intoxicating liquor and alcoholic beverages shall only be allowed after the execution of a rental agreement with and the issuance of a permit. The rental agreement shall be executed after proper review of a State license to sell intoxicating liquor by the drink, where drinks will be offered for sale during the proposed event and as otherwise required by State law.

Renters shall be required to provide to the City a copy of an insurance certificate in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence and one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) aggregate and one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) in host liquor liability naming the City of Hallsville as an additional insured before they are permitted to host an event at City property wherein alcoholic beverages and intoxicating liquors shall be served, provided, or otherwise present.

### **Insurance Requirements:**

Renters hosting events where alcohol is served must provide proof of insurance prior to the event.

Required coverage includes:

- \$1,000,000 per occurrence
- \$1,000,000 aggregate
- \$1,000,000 host liquor liability

The City of Hallsville must be listed as an additional insured on the policy.
