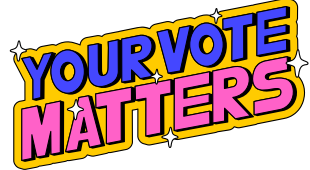
- **April 1st:** Emergency sirens are tested the first Wednesday of every month at noon!
- **April 3rd:** Good Friday!
- **April 5th:** Easter!
- **April 7th:** Election Day!
- **April 10th:** Accounts signed up for automatic withdraw payments for City water and/or trash will have payments removed from your checking account.
- **April 13th:** A 5% penalty is added to all water and/or trash accounts that are unpaid.
- **April 13th:** The Board of Aldermen will have their regular monthly meeting at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall.
- **April 21st:** A \$35 nonpayment fee will be added to all water and/or trash accounts that are unpaid. Services will be discontinued. Needing help with your bill? Call City Hall by the 20th to make a payment arrangement.



For the General Municipal Election scheduled on Tuesday, April 7, 2026, registered voters in Hallsville are required to cast their ballots at their designated polling location.

Change in Online Bill Pay Website

What changes are occurring with online bill payment? *Paystar* will eventually be discontinued as an option for online bill payments, even for those with automatic payments set up through the platform. The new website for payments is <https://bit.ly/4b94DT8>, or you can use the accompanying QR code.



Upon visiting the site, you will need to click on "Don't have an account? Register here." During registration, enter "1" for the Book Number and your account number, which can be found on your bill. If you need assistance locating your bill number, please contact City Hall. Additionally, you will be required to provide the

first line of your service address as it appears on your bill, along with an email address. Once registered, the CUBIC Utility Billing software offers an integrated Internet Inquiry Module, facilitating secure online payment processing, which typically includes options for credit and debit card payments, electronic checks (ACH), and automated recurring payments. This portal will enable customers to view their usage history and manage their accounts effectively.

Hallsville Area Chamber of Commerce

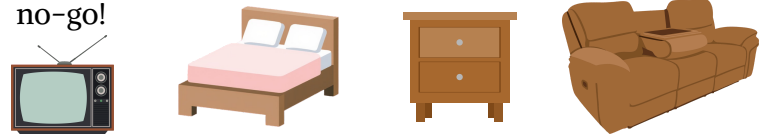
