- **February 11th:** A 5% penalty is added to all water and/or trash accounts that are unpaid.
- **February 16th:** City Hall will be closed to observe Presidents' Day.
- **February 23rd:** A \$35 nonpayment fee will be added to all water and/or trash accounts that are unpaid. Services will be discontinued. Needing help with your bill? Call City Hall by the 20th to make a payment arrangement.
